Sub: TGEJAC – Long pending demands of TG employees – unresolved - Agitation program chalked out and submitted - Reg

Ref: Resolution of TGEJAC meeting, Dated:07.04.2026

We are to submit that Telangana employees JAC representing on behalf of 15.31 lakhs Employees, Teachers, Gazetted Officers, Pensioners, Outsourcing and Contract Employees at about 206 Constituent Organizations. On 7.4.2026 State-Level Executive Committee Meeting held and as per resolution adopted during the above meeting we are compel to go for phased manner agitation for resolving long pending legitimate demands of employees. In the first phase, lunch hour demonstration duly wearing black badge on ~~17~~4-2026 in all Mandal Offices, District Collectorates, HoDs, Hyderabad City including Secretariat.

We are put-forth four major, long pending issues of Telangana State Government employees for immediate relief before the Government.

1. **Obtain and Implementation of 2nd PRC report before 2nd June, 2026.**

Pay Revision Committee (PRC) under the chairmanship of Sri N. Siva Sankar, IAS (Rtd), constituted on 2-10-2023 to submit its report within 6 months and Commission also consulted all Departments and Service Associations / Union and recorded their views, but report is still awaited. Nearly 30 months completed from the constitution and also lapsed more than 24 months for its report. Employees are agitating for the delay in report from PRC and we request to obtain and implement the report before 2nd June, 2026 without any further delay. We also demand to release the pending DA / DR immediately to meet the inflation.

2. Release of Pending Bills:

Government has assured to release Rs.700 crores every month towards pending bills, however, every month nearly 600 employees are retiring from service on attaining the age of superannuation. Retirement benefits are also pending for release for quite time and pensioners are facing much inconvenience and financial burden to meet their medical expenses, children education, children marriage etc., and some of them were expired due mental agony. Therefore, we demand to release immediately Rs.13000 crores of pending bills of pensioners to give relief to their families.

3. Health Cards to Employees / Pensioners.

During number of meeting, Chief Secretary sir has assured to implement the recommendations of Cabinet Sub-Committee on Health Cards duly framing guidelines. Employees and Pensioners are facing much difficult / inconvenience. Therefore, we demand to frame guidelines on EHS Scheme immediately, so as enable to get the benefits of the scheme by employees / pensioners with effect 1-5-2026 positively.

4. Implement Old Pension Scheme

- (a) We demand to abolish the new pension scheme i.e., Contributory Pension Scheme [CPS] and restore the old pension scheme in the State immediately.
- (b) Old Pension Scheme (OPS) must be implemented immediately for employees appointed through notification prior to September 1, 2004

Therefore in view of the above circumstances, we once again request the Government immediately resolve the above major demands and also remaining 64 long-pending issues the employees and oblige.

We solicit favorable action in the matter.
