Sub:- Joint Action Committee of Telangana Employees, Gazetted Officers, Teachers, Workers & Pensioners, Hyderabad – Request to obtain the report on Revision of Pay in r/o State Government employees and not to further extension of PRC Committee - Reg

We submit the following lines for your kind consideration and necessary orders at the earliest.

We bring to your kind notice Government have constituted the Pay Revision Committee (PRC) under the chairmanship of Sri N. Siva Sankar, IAS (Rtd), to review the existing pay structure and allowances to State Government employees and give its recommendations as per terms of reference, within a period of six months vide G.O. Ms. No. 159, G.A. (Spl.A) Dept., dt: 2.10.2023. Accordingly, PRC under the chairmanship of Sri N. Siva Sankar, IAS (Rtd) have received the proposals from service associations of the State of Telangana and Department wise review also been completed. Commission also met with each association recorded their views on the proposal of review of existing pay structure and allowances, etc., in r/o State Government employees.

It is also pertinent to mention that Government employees are not in a position to meet the basic requirements like tuition fees for their children, medical

expenditure for family members including old age parents and EMI on Housing loans etc., due to there is abnormal difference between the income and inflation. For the reason, the employees are in deficit of minimum by Rs.20,000/- pm and meet the same, they are forced to approach to raise more loans, which resulting in the financial burden.

Further, it is to inform that the recommendations of the PRC are due as on by 2-4-2024 i.e., within six months. As on date 24 months were lapsed (total 30 months) for want of recommendations of PRC and due to the above, Government employees are loosing their legitimate right.

Therefore, we request your goodselves to kindly obtain the report of Commission on the revision of pay in r/o State Government employees immediately without any further delay and further requested not to extend PRC Committee Period.

We solicit favorable action in the matter.
